



Holder 14 MkII

Welcome to the new-generation family daysailor, the Holder 14 Mark II by Hobie Cat, the most stable one-design performance monohull under 16 feet L.O.A. A quick look will explain why Hobie Cat is so proud of this exciting boat.



Quality Construction

Hobie Cat is the innovator in fiberglass construction. The Holder 14 Mark II shows why. It features hand-laid fiberglass

vacuum formed over a structural foam core for a very strong, stiff, but lightweight boat that planes easily

Longitudinal fiberglass hull I-beams create even more strength. The hardened chine increases stability so the boat is forgiving without being slow.



Centerboard and Rudder

Our research and design team created a foiled, spring-action centerboard to increase both performance and convenience. This new board is easy to use because it retracts into its own well inside the boar's hull. If the board should hit an

obstruction, it simply retracts so no major damage is done to the boat or the board.

The fiberglass rudder has been specially shaped for greater efficiency and performance. The rudder assembly is spring loaded for convenience and safety. One quick motion pops the rudder up or returns it to its "down" position. Like the centerboard, the rudder will raise itself should it hit an obstruction, or if you forget to raise it before beaching.





The Holder 14 Mark II is designed with the family in mind. It sails four adults easily and the ample, eight-foot cockpit space can stow gear and lunch for everybody. The cockpit is totally self-bailing. The boat's wide, flat hull shape is shallow and slightly rounded to increase planing ability.

The hardware is the best. The tracts and shrouds are heavy duty stainless steel; the blocks are Harken. The jib sail is large for more power. The optional roller furling system makes for easy storage and a quick reduction in jib sail area when needed. The tough Dacron sails are hand sewn in Hobie Cat's own sail loft. The mast is a light, high strength aluminum alloy topped with the exclusive Comptip™ mast tip, an essentially non-conductive composite that improves sail control in higher winds and helps protect sailors against the danger of overhead electrical power lines. (Sailors should always avoid contact of the mast with an electrical powerline, even with the Comptip™). Teak splash rails, and an extruded aluminum rub

rail with plastic inserts to protect against dockside damage, are built right into the Holder 14 Mark II. This is a boat you'll be proud to own.

Built-in Safety

In addition to the Comptip™ mast, the Holder 14 Mark II has many other safety features. Positive foam flotation sufficient to float five adults, the boat. gear and a small motor, makes the Holder 14 virtually unsinkable. The flotation, the raised foredeck and the boat's light weight make it easy to right in the event of a capsize. Coated wires help prevent scratches and cuts, and protect the sails. Antislip non-skid is molded right into the deck for effective, not abrasive, slip protection. And, most importantly, the hard chine of the Holder 14 assures inherent stability that allows for occasional mistakes. It's got a friendly temperament.
